

**Schedule WWS
WHOLESALE WATER SERVICE
Effective August 2, 2011**

(Supersedes Schedule WWS Effective January 2, 2011)

AVAILABILITY

Subject to approval by the Board of Directors of each contract for deliveries here under, this rate is available for and required of municipal and other governmental entities purchasing water for distribution and/or resale to ultimate consumers for residential, commercial, industrial, irrigation and other purposes.

RATE - MONTHLY BILLING

Demand charge:

First 10,000 thousand gallons of monthly billing demand	\$.3467 per 1,000 gal.
In excess of 10,000 thousand gallons of monthly billing demand	\$.2989 per 1,000 gal.

Commodity charge:

First 10,000 thousand gallons per month	\$.5914 per 1,000 gal.
In excess of 10,000 thousand gallons per month	\$.5499 per 1,000 gal.

MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

The minimum monthly charge shall be \$4,668.00 or the monthly demand charge, whichever is greater.

DETERMINATION OF MONTHLY BILLING DEMAND

A. Monthly billing demand shall be determined as follows:

$$\frac{\text{Maximum daily demand} \times 365}{12 \text{ months}}$$

but shall not be less than the highest monthly billing demand established during the prior eleven-month period.

- B.** Maximum daily demand shall be determined by contract provisions which shall be one of the following:
1. The maximum rate of flow in gallons per minute controlled by a rate of flow controller multiplied by 1,440 minutes. The rate of flow shall be set according to written agreement between District and customer. In the absence of equipment which will record the rate of flow, the maximum flow allowed by the rate of flow controller is assumed to also be the maximum day rate of flow.
 2. Customer may elect to have installed at customer's expense metering and recording equipment approved by the District. The maximum daily demand shall then be (.70 x maximum average gallons per minute recorded during any 15-minute period between 4:00 PM and 10:00 PM and during the month of May to September inclusive x 1,440 minutes) or the actual maximum-day consumption measured from midnight to midnight during the months of May to September, inclusive, whichever is greater.

PAYMENT

Bills rendered at the above schedules are due and payable within 15 days of date of bill unless otherwise provided for by contract.

CONTRACT

Customer must execute written agreement with District for a term of not less than five (5) years which is made a part of this rate schedule.
