General

Certain criteria have been established to effectively remove any obsolete or inferior hydrants from the distribution system.

Obsolete Hydrants

If the following hydrants are involved in a main extension or relocation project, they are not to be reused. They should be returned to the Stores department for parts or credit as CI scrap. Many of these hydrants are obsolete and parts are not available. Others are a poor quality of hydrant.
