

M.U.D. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Metropolitan Utilities District (M.U.D.) will have a contractor on site at our Walnut Hill Reservoir located at 38th and 40th Streets from Hamilton to Nicholas Streets.

Q: WHAT WORK WILL BE HAPPENING?

A: Removal of the existing membrane material on the roof of the reservoir.

Q: WHY IS THIS OCCURRING?

A: The existing roofing material is deteriorating at the location.

Q: WHEN WILL THIS PROJECT START?

A: This project is anticipated to start October 2023, barring any unplanned delays.

Q: HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO COMPLETE?

A: This project is expected to last 18 weeks.

Q: WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF OPERATION?

A. Our contractor's normal hours of operation will be 7 a.m.- 4 p.m., Monday-Friday.

Q: WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

A: A minimal amount of noise and dust. Some heavy equipment driving through your neighborhood.

Q: WILL TRAFFIC BE AFFECTED AND WILL THERE BE LANE RESTRICTIONS?

A: There should be no lane restrictions as the project will occur on the reservoir's fenced-in property.
