GAS AND WATER INFRASTRUCTURE REPLACEMENT This project may require the replacement of your gas and/or water service line and meter to your home, all at no cost to you.

LOCATE UTILITIES

A technician from M.U.D. will be marking utilities with flags or paint. For the safety of everyone, please do not remove these flags or markings.

DIG EXCAVATIONS

Excavations of various sizes will be dug to access the existing gas and water services and for main installation. Generally, the larger holes on street corners will remain open for the duration of the project to make final connections at the end of the project.

INSTALL NEW GAS AND WATER MAINS

The crew plans to install the mains underground and under driveways. If necessary, driveways may be impacted and will be restored.

RECONNECT SERVICES

Homes and businesses will be reconnected to the new mains. This will include temporary brief gas and water service interruptions which typically lasts 4 hours or less. You will be notified in advance of any planned service interruption. Please watch for a notification on your door.

FINAL CONNECTION AND ABANDONMENT OF OLD MAINS

After main installation and service reconnection work is completed, final connections will be made and the old mains will be taken out of service. This work will be done in the larger corner excavations and will include temporary brief gas and water service interruptions which typically lasts 4 hours or less. You will be notified in advance of any planned service interruption. Please watch for a notification on your door.



Restoration of lawns, landscaping, sidewalks, driveways, and streets will be performed at the end of the project and/or as weather permits.

WHY

M.U.D. must relocate the gas and water mains ahead of the City of Omaha's street improvement Project OPW 54285.

WHEN AND HOW LONG

Work will begin very soon however we are not able to give a specific start date due to unplanned delays such as weather, equipment, current projects, or emergencies. Project duration is expected to be several months.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING

Possible lane restrictions may exist. Parking on the street may be restricted. For the safety of everyone, please slow down when driving in the area.

TO PREPARE FOR A WATER INTERRUPTION

To continue using a tank-style toilet, fill a container with water and have a bucket nearby to scoop water into the toilet tank and fill about halfway for each flush. Fill containers with water and keep on hand during the interruption to allow for handwashing and drinking.

AFTER A WATER INTERRUPTION

It is normal for air to be in the water lines after a water interruption; please run your COLD water for about 10 minutes to release the air.

DURING AND AFTER A GAS INTERRUPTION

Any appliance in your home or business that uses gas will not be available during the interruption (i.e., stove, water heater, furnace/boiler, etc.). Gas pilots will be relit by a technician from M.U.D. after the interruption.



Hydrants are generally in easement or Right of Way (ROW) and may be moved to accommodate the new main location and meet all fire codes.
